- How you implemented this innovative research, planning, design or operations management?
- The cost-savings or benefits delivered to your business and industry?
- The impact of this activity
- The complexity of the problem or situation addressed.

Our judges will award scores based on the following criteria:

- Inventiveness (up to 15 marks): Is the project original? What is new or different?
- **Practicality** (*up to 10 marks*): Was the project well planned/researched prior to work commencing?
- Drivers (up to 10 marks): What were the key drivers? What issues had to be overcome,
 i.e. was this an historical/unusual building?
- Impact (up to 10 marks): Were any significant technical problems overcome? Was the resolution suitable/well considered?
- **Diffusion/Spread and Adoption (up to 5 marks):** If there is a unique approach, is there potential for this to be adopted by other companies?
